Will Sisson Memorial & Kansas State Championship

As-Issued Garand, Springfield, Vintage and Modern Military Match Program

CMP-sanctioned Games As-Issued rifle match on October 5, 2025, in honor of Will Sisson, a well known and long-time high power shooter. This match is also classified as the CMP Games Kansas State Championship.

LOCATION: Millcreek Rifle Club, 7215 Gardner Rd, De Soto, KS 66018.

ENTRY FEE: \$20 / \$5 for Juniors

REGISTRATION & SQUADDING: Register and receive scorecards at 9:00a at the pavilion. First shots downrange at 10:00a. Relays will be squadded at registration with accommodations made for anyone sharing equipment. Participants will alternate between firing the full match and verifying scores for the other relay.

SCORING / VERIFICATION: Matches will use Shotmarker electronic targets. Please bring a mobile device to monitor targets and verify scores.

COURSE OF FIRE: As-Issued Military Rifle Match Course A. All stages are fired from 200 yards on the SR target.

- 5 sighters and 10 record shots slow fire prone in 15 minutes
- 10 shots rapid fire prone from standing in 80 seconds
- 10 shots slow fire standing in 10 minutes

RULES: The Millcreek CMP Games Rifle Matches are governed by the current edition of the <u>CMP Games Rifle & Pistol Competition Rules</u>. Empty chamber indicators (ECIs), eye and ear protection are required.

Competitors must use "as-issued" rifles for the following matches.

- U.S. M1 Garand or M1 Carbine in the John C. Garand Match
- M1903 or M1903A3 rifles in the Springfield Match
- U. S. Krag-Jorgensen, M1917 or manually operated foreign military rifles in the Vintage Military Match

Competitors may use semi-automatic military rifles from the US or foreign manufacture, or commercial rifles of same type and caliber for the following Modern Military matches:

- AR-type rifles with metallic sights in caliber 5.56 mm or .223 for Modern Military Category A
- Other US or foreign rifles with metallic sights in any caliber not exceeding 8 mm for Modern Military Category B

There will be no Unlimited Garand or Unlimited Modern categories.

AWARDS: CMP Championship medals will be awarded to the top finishers in each rifle category; John C. Garand, Springfield, Vintage Military and Modern Military.

The overall winner of the John C. Garand match will have their name engraved on the Will Sisson Memorial plaque located in the Millcreek Rifle Club trophy case.

ABOUT WILL SISSON: Known to his family and friends as Sonny, he was a member of Millcreek Rifle Club since 2006. Born in St. Louis, Missouri, Sisson joined the Marine Corps following high school, where he served for 20 years and retired with the rank of Captain. Following his retirement, he worked at Brinks; starting as an armed guard and working his way up to manager. After his retirement from Brinks, he worked for the American Red Cross where he also did volunteer work.

While in the Marine Corps he was a Rifle Marksman and on the competition team. While stationed in Okinawa, Will picked up Karate and achieved the rank of black belt. He had a passion for teaching gun safety including hunter and women's safety courses. Sisson carried on his love of shooting throughout his life, was a well known high power competitor and shared his love of shooting with his children and grandchildren.
